

Regional Home Visiting Systems Coordination Project

Systems Survey Highlights Year 8: Siskiyou, CA Region

Context

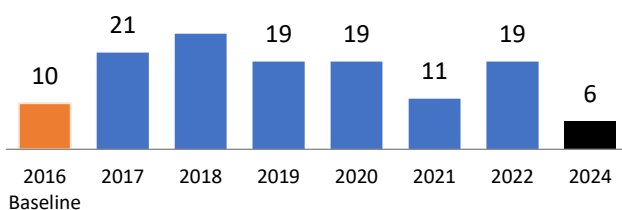


Beginning in 2016, The Ford Family Foundation began funding a Regional Home Visiting Systems Coordination (HVSC) project. The vision for the project is

for Siskiyou County to have a coordinated home visiting system that strengthens and benefits all home visiting models as part of each region's early childhood development system. The long-term goal for the project is to improve outcomes for children and families and expand the region's capacity to serve more families.

To assess change over time, a survey asking about the regional home visiting system was administered with key partners to provide a cross-sectional data point, following baseline in 2016 and each year thereafter.

Six respondents in 2024 represented a 100% response rate.



Based on the 2024 survey responses, there are some clear areas of progress that respondents highlighted, as well as areas for continued growth, hopes for where work can focus, and challenges that will need to be navigated.

Key Accomplishments

Building new and maintaining existing relationships among staff and between programs.

Sustaining governance and planning structures for partners to work on systems change goals.

Continuing to sustain efforts that promote shared professional development opportunities among partners.

Opportunities for Growth

Communicating a cross-program home visiting training plan with home visiting and family support program partners

Identifying opportunities to coordinate with regional and state partners around community awareness raising efforts of HV and family support programs available to families, and benefits of participation.

Hopes for Coming Year

Continuing work to expand use of coordinated referral forms and systems among existing and new community partners.

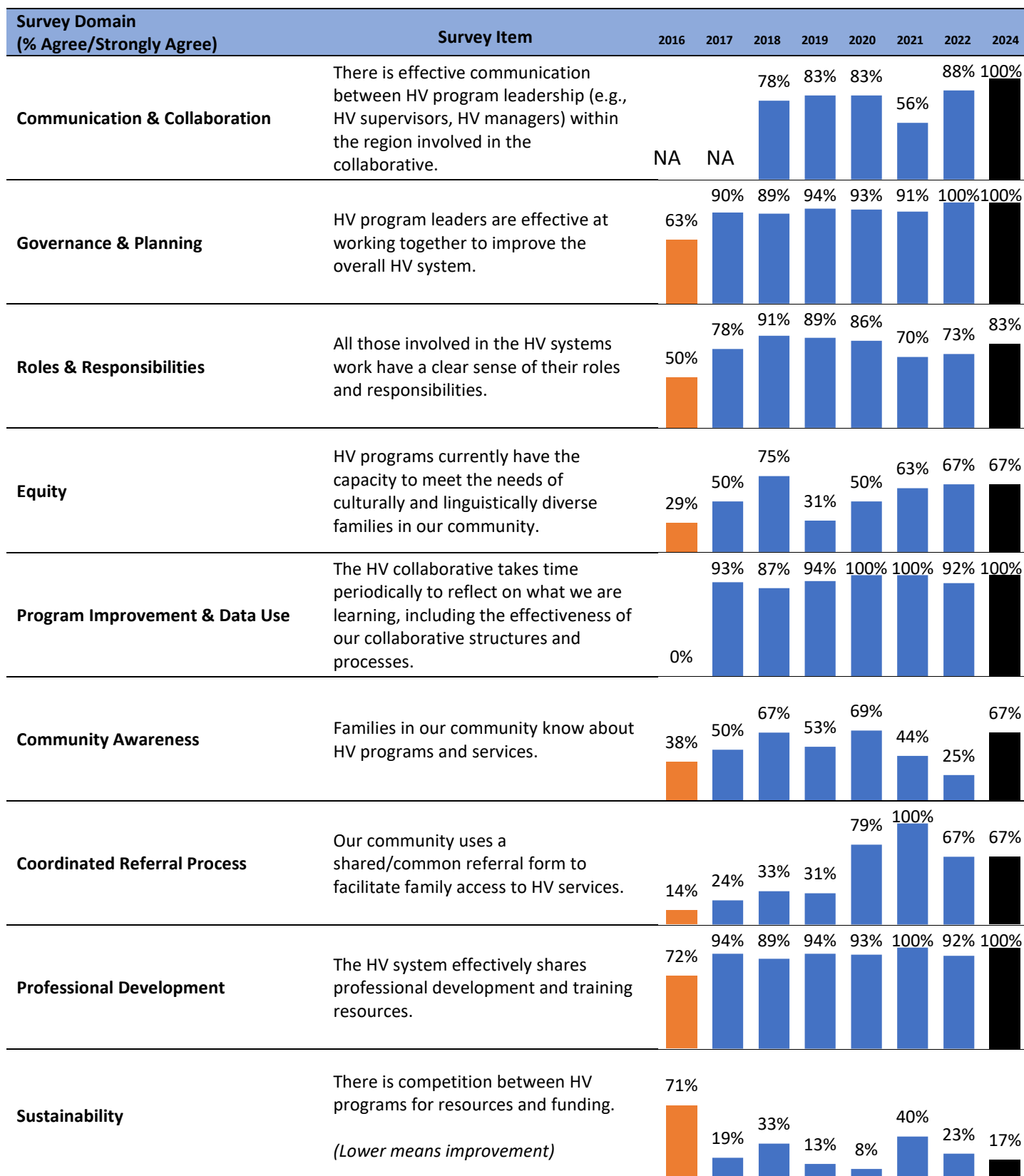
Engaging parents as leaders in decision-making to inform systems change.

Continuing to build awareness with community partners and families to understand the availability and benefits of HV supports in the community.

Challenges to be Addressed

Engaging partners in strategic planning around shared goals.

Resourcing systems change work in order for partners to meaningfully engage.
